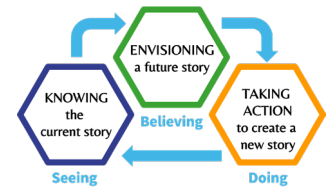

With the guidance of facilitators and mentors, they work in their respective communities to grow community engagement and visible progress towards community performance excellence that improves outcomes in the areas of health, education, the economy, housing, and other aspects of quality of life. Following is the curriculum for the third phase of this journey.



OBJECTIVES:

1. Sustain your community excellence group's [CEG] participation in your Communities of Excellence [COE] Journey.
2. Design and manage your key CEG processes in the areas of improvement, innovation, and sustainability and apply them to the implementation of your initial action project's strategic plan while also developing a comprehensive five-year strategic plan for your Communities of Excellence initiative. Your plan will include ensuring leadership capacity and capability development.
3. **Take Action to Create Your Community's New Story:** Expand your journey's story and receive objective feedback on the Frameworks' Category 4-7 questions in full on measurement, analysis and knowledge management, people resources, operations, and results through COE's Assessment and Recognition Program.
4. Learn how your cross-sector community performance excellence initiative is an innovative collaborative approach to community development.
5. Learn about and engage with the other communities in the COE National Learning Collaborative.
