1. Submit the Community Assessment and Recognition Panel Reviewer Application.
2. Commit to serving for one year. A new application should be submitted each year.
3. Reviewers must commit to high work standards, meet team deadlines, maintain confidentiality, conduct themselves with the highest of ethical standards and integrity.

Time Commitment

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| Level 1 – Commitment to Community Excellence (Reviewers can be assigned at any time throughout the year) | 10-20 hours |
| Level 2 – Journey to Community Excellence | 20-30 hours |
| Level 3 – Community of Excellence (Experienced Reviewers may be asked to participate in training and coaching sessions, and serve as judges) | 40-60 |
